Resale restrictions will apply to maintain affordability for subsequent buyers.

Each applicant who, based on the information provided on the application, appears to qualify, will be included in a lottery. Applicants with the greatest likelihood of being housed, based upon lottery number, will be given the opportunity to document their household eligibility, qualification for financing, and cash for closing, and to review condominium documents and long-term affordability covenants. The successful applicant must be prepared to purchase as soon as possible.
